Team Name: Mound City Solar

Description: Mound City Solar proposes to significantly reduce energy costs for the residents of Mound City, a predominantly black, disadvantaged community in East Jackson, Tennessee. Using DOE Inclusive Energy Innovation Phase I funds, the Mound City Solar Initiative will install solar generation systems in 20 new-build, low-income Mound City homes in 2022. In addition, the Mound City Solar Initiative will develop an accredited energy and sustainable systems Associate's degree course and a solar installer certification course for implementation at Lane College, a historically Black college in Jackson.
