
JEDI Solution

Goal: Get low income families to adopt solar.

Problem / Challenge: The cost structure for residential solar shows the small size residential solar payback time is too long. The current policy has a relatively negative impact on the low income community.

JEDI Solution – A new solar incentive and finance program enables reduced payback time for small projects that enable low income communities to adopt solar.
