Ensuring an equitable green transition in California's Central Valley

Founded in 2022, the Central Valley Inclusive Innovation Hub (CViiHub<sup>2</sup>) builds upon existing resources to amplify impact throughout the region and is anchored by key partnerships. The partners are selected based on their strong and aligned engagement with diverse stakeholders and are guided by principles to support underserved communities.





The primary mission of CViiHub<sup>2</sup> is to spur business and job creation through the commercialization of clean energy, agricultural, and climate-smart technologies. Through the Community Energy Challenge, the ambition is to amend the mission statement to bolster student engagement and to ensure the region's local communities have equitable access to financial and programmatic support.

## ACTION PLAN

**Identify:** Identify, assess, and promote existing clean energy initiatives, rebates, and services in California's San Joaquin Valley to ensure equitable information sharing and outreach to rural communities.

**Engage:** Engage with students from the region's minority-serving institutions to educate, inspire, and cultivate the next-generation workforce.

**Connect:** Connect clean energy startup companies and their services to rural communities in order to increase energy resiliency in our region's disadvantaged communities.

**Expand:** Continue to provide technical assistance and commercialization services and expand the network of community and industry partners and groups dedicated to fostering a just and inclusive innovation ecosystem.

## JUSTICE40 ALIGNMENT

The CviiHub<sup>2</sup> mission is closely aligned with the Justice40 Initiative and is focused almost exclusively on underserved rural communities with a strong focus on minority groups. The coalition integrates multiple special programmatic elements targeted at supporting equity across the Central Valley. The project will support resilience through inclusion and access.
