- Planning two community solar projects for the Tule River Tribe
- Assessing solar opportunities with Tribes in California, Idaho, Oklahoma, and Nebraska.
- Partnership with California Energy Commission on Grid Resilience focusing on the Tule River Indian Tribe, Tejon Indian Tribe and California Native American Tribes.
