Proposed Organization: Solar for Good, a proposed 501 (c)(3) nonprofit, will be a co-developer and owner of community solar projects, where the profits generated by the community solar projects are reinvested back into local charitable efforts to build equity in local communities and drive economic development.

The Vision: Solar for Good views community solar projects not as an end in themselves, but as community-based economic engines that can help address some of the toughest problems facing our communities.

The Mission – Solar for Good partners with community banks, local governments, and community development organizations to develop community solar projects at the lowest possible cost and then use the profits from the solar project to support charitable causes, solve unique problems facing the community, and drive economic development.

The Goal – By 2026, Solar for Good plans to be developing greater than 70MW of community solar per year. With our Equity Distribution Allocation of at least \$200k annually per project, we aspire to commit over \$50 million in charitable investment into our LMI and disadvantaged communities each year.
