



At Furniture Repair Bank we envision a future where **furniture waste is eliminated**, repair **skills are fostered** for generations, and vulnerable households have **access to quality furniture**.

Impact

- Bringing 3000 items/year back in circulation that translate in 15,000 US tons of waste prevented and 1,2M kgCO2eq avoided
- 300%+ increased product lifetime
- 30 jobs per site created
- 100+ Partnerships formed
- 16,000h hands-on volunteer trainings that increase community resilience
- Supporting 750+ individuals in 50+ families a year with free furniture
- Providing on the job training to 20 vulnerable community members
