Why Bithlo, Florida?

Bithlo is a town that has been forgotten – until now. Once an incorporated town, economic hardship bankrupted Bithlo in 1929, and attempts to revitalize the government there failed. In 1977, the state Legislature abolished it for good, making it an unincorporated part of Orange County, Florida, which promptly ignored it. Toxic chemicals make children's teeth fall out. Addiction, prostitution, and poverty are rampant. Energy poverty is significant, with many residents living without electricity or running water. Efforts have been made over the last decade by a coalition of partners but there is still much work to be done. This project will educate and empower citizens of Bithlo to SOLVE IT and get access to renewable energy, freely!

The community desperately needs cooperation and coordination. We have partnered with churches, Rotary clubs, medical professionals, and fellow community organizations. We have invited mission workers from various churches to volunteer their time, and asked medical professionals to offer check-ups, eye exams and dental cleanings to those who needed them most. In 2010, our partner for this project, United Global Outreach, opened a K-3 school for the community to help its most at-risk students succeed. Today, we are working to build a town center in Bithlo. complete with a coffee shop, a community center, a community school, an aquaponics garden.

This project will organize citizens and take them through our award winning program for planning energy projects called The IDEAS Hive, and we will create an energy hub within the community powered by solar.
