The Community

- Located in SE Ann Arbor, MI
- 262-home neighborhood
- One story, single-family homes built circa 1970
- 50% BIPOC
- 50% owned, 50% rented
- 30% of households are energy-burdened

The Project

To achieve whole neighborhood decarbonization, the Team will create a **regional geothermal district** to decarbonize heating and cooling throughout the entire neighborhood. This, stacked with weatherization and solar will lead to a **75% reduction in GHG emissions** and **cost savings of 77%**.

- 88 residents attended 3 projectspecific events
- Energy assessments on **80** homes
- **30** resident letters of support
