


# How To: Submit Your Prize Submission via HeroX

To submit your application to an American-Made prize, please follow the steps below:


## Step 1: Sign-Up and Follow the Prize on HeroX

Navigate to the HeroX landing page which will look something like this: [www.herox.com/PRIZENAME](https://www.herox.com/PRIZENAME) and click on “Follow”. You will need to log into your existing HeroX account or create a new one.




## Step 2: Click on “Solve This Challenge”

Click on the “Solve This Challenge Button”




## Step 4: Accept Competitor Agreement

Click “Accept” on the competitor agreements.

When you reach the bottom of the document, Accept Button will be enabled.



## Step 3: Competitor Registration


Next, choose how you want to sign up for the prize. You can select:

- **Yes, I want to create my own team:** This option creates a “team” on HeroX which allows multiple people to collaborate on a submission.
- **Yes, I want to join a team:** This option allows you to search for and join an existing team
- **No, I want to compete individually:** This allows you to create a submission without creating or joining a team on HeroX. If you choose this option, you can still represent a team, but only you will have access to the HeroX submission.



If you select either of the teaming options, follow the prompts to create or join a team.





## Step 3: Begin Entry
