

L-Prize Manufacturing and Installation Phase Office Hours

The L-Prize team is offering office hours to potential Manufacturing and Installation (M&I) Phase entrants. These office hours provide an opportunity for potential competitors to ask questions about the competition rules and requirements and share feedback with DOE. The office hours will be hosted by DOE's technical lead for the L-Prize, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL), and must be booked in advance. Each session will be limited to 30 minutes and will be attended by only one potential entrant (competitor or team) at a time.

During office hours, PNNL will listen to questions and feedback and may ask for clarifying information from the potential entrant about their questions or feedback. To ensure that all potential competitors have access to the same information, answers to questions received relevant to all potential entrants will be publicly posted following the session to the [L-Prize HeroX Forum](#). The identity of potential entrants who attend a session will remain confidential and no identifying information about potential entrants will be included in any follow-up HeroX Forum posts. Please note that no coaching will be provided to potential entrants during these sessions about design, products, team, points earned, or any other aspects that may provide a competitive advantage to the potential entrants.
