NREL Site Logistics

- The NREL STM requires an ID to access.
 - All visitors must check-in and have an ID on them.
 - All visitors must be <u>registered</u> in advance.
 - Non-US citizens will be sent a 'data card' and this must be completed at least 2weeks prior to attending.
- Visitors require an escort while in buildings.
- There is a lot of construction. Watch for signage and trucks.

Scoring Criteria

The presentation and final report will both be scored 0–5, as shown here, on how well they address the statements in each criteria. Remember to read the rules for these statements!

The weight of each scored submission requirement is outlined below:

Submission Component	Potential Points	% of Total Score
Phase III Technical Narrative	80	32%
Phase III TPL Assessment	15	6%
Test Report	20	8%
Leaderboard Engagement	15	6%
Virtual Interview and Demonstration	40*	16%
Final Event Design Presentation	80	32%
TOTAL	250	100%

^{*}Competitors scores are multiplied by 2 for a total of 40 possible points.

Final Presentation

- Final Event Design Presentation
 - Live at NREL on March 6th.
 - At least one team member in person, with virtual participation possible.
 - Present on lessons learned, end-use application, and future plans to a panel of 3-5 expert reviewers
 - Assigned reviewers will have reviewed your materials in advance
 - Focus on storytelling. You may bring slides, videos, and physical materials to assist in your presentation
- 30-minute presentation
 - Closed-door to other competitors/public
 - 30-minute Q&A
